A compatible SFP must match the vendor ID to avoid: LINK-PP modules can be coded to match major brands, making them suitable for mixed-brand. I am planning on buying a TP-LINK TL-SG2424 gigabit switch with 4 SFP module ports. I can get a TP-LINK TL-SM311LS SFP module for it for about \$36 or a cheaper D-Link DEM-310GT for about \$6. The question is, are these SFP transceivers generally all interchangeable with different manufacturer's.
