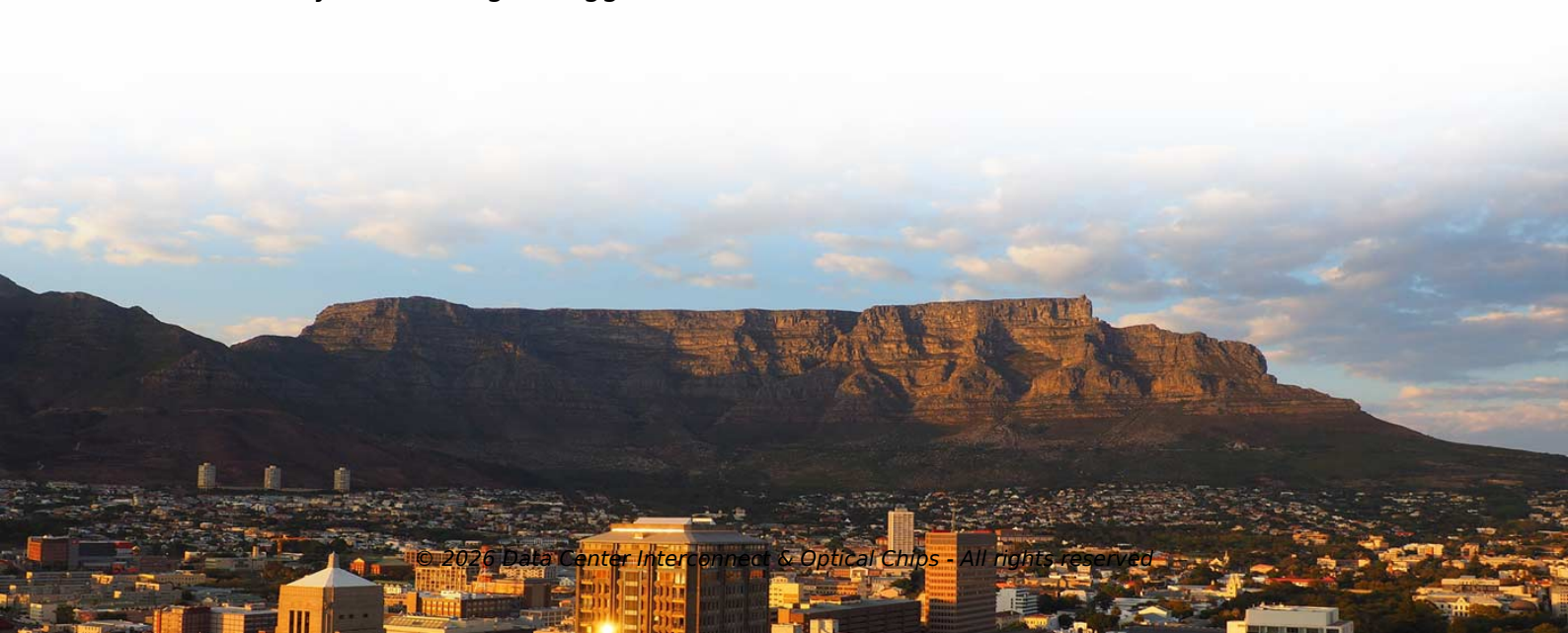


# Cable tray bend against the wall



## Overview

Simply make the appropriate cuts in the side wall of the tray you are joining a length to, bend down the side wall, and attach a TX bracket either side. Riser links must always be installed in pairs, one on each side of the tray.
