

Can control cables and electrical cables be run in the same cable tray



Overview

Never run both types in the same conduit or tray. Crossing: If power and control cables must cross, do so at a 90-degree angle to minimize electromagnetic coupling. A common question arises: Can power cables and instrumentation/communication cables be run in the same cable tray?
