Overview

Combustible materials must not be stored within one metre of an electrical distribution board or cabinet. Internal doors are closed at the end of the day. The use of equipment rooms to store items, such as those needed. The dangerous substances and Explosive Atmospheres Regulations 2002 (DSEAR) require risks from the indoor storage of dangerous substances to be controlled by elimination or by reducing the quantities of such substances in the workplace to a minimum and providing mitigation to protect against. Electrical switchgear and distribution boards can be a potential source of ignition, if combustible materials are within reach. Where a small enclosure is used to house electrical distribution. Scenario: Typically, the flammable liquid usage in pharmaceutical manufacturing operations involves Isopropyl Alcohol or Ethanol for chromatography column regeneration and buffer preparation. Examples of such materials include cleaning products, cardboard, plastics, foam, rubber, furniture, loose packaging material, and empty cooking oil containers.
