

Distribution box tripped and couldn't be pushed back up factory



Overview

The trick here is to push the big black button down, until it clicks, and then push it back up to the top and it should click into position. There are several different situations that would keep a circuit from being reactivated after a breaker has been tripped. Here's the three most common ones: When a breaker has been tripped—whether it's because of pushing the test button on a GFCI or AFCI breaker, or because of an overcurrent.
