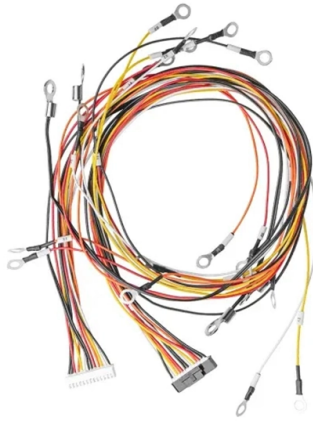


# Do pigtails always need a terminal box
