

Does the cable tray run an air pipe



Overview

Can you run a cable tray inside an air duct?

Absolutely not. This would severely obstruct airflow, violate building regulations, and create an extreme fire hazard. Question 1: Can mechanical utility piping or tubing containing water or compressed air be installed in cable trays with electrical cables?

Answer: No. Cable trays are a support system for electrical cables, power, signal, and communication and optical fiber cables. NEC section 300-8 does not permit. Shared Support Systems: While a cable tray cannot support an air duct, both systems can often be fixed to the same primary structural steelwork or suspended from the same concrete slab, provided the supports are engineered for the combined load. cables can usually (not always) be pulled from one end, or at least pulled through straight sections between tray elbows/tees without uncapping the whole tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
