

Fiber Optic Cable Connector Attenuation Test Standard



Overview

The IEC has published a new standard for the testing of fibre optic cabling. IEC 61280-4-5 provides test methods to measure the attenuation of installed multimode and single-mode optical fibre cabling plant as well as the determination of their polarity and length. Fiber optic testing of a newly installed system not only verifies that the system meets its design requirements, but also creates a performance baseline for all future testing and troubleshooting of the system. Corning recommends that all fiber optic systems be tested to a minimum set. The National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA) and National Electrical Installation Standards (NEIS) provide state-by-state licensing and regulation details for fiber optic contractors. Any connector design is permitted as long as it has a FOCIS document (Fiber Optic Connector Intermateability Standard). All small form factor connectors with FOCIS documents are acceptable.
