

# How to fix the grounding busbar of the distribution box



## Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be  $< .$  An electrical panel box, also known as a breaker box or a distribution board, is a crucial component of any electrical system. The new panel I would like to install (A Square D QO) has doubled up bus bars that only come down about 30% of the length of the box. For the old install, the large (#2 I believe) ground wire feeding. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. In DC systems, such as those found in RVs, boats, or solar power setups, busbars organize complex wiring into a clean, orderly arrangement.
