

How to open the bottom of a network cabinet



Overview

Tilt the Rear Side Panel and insert bottom Hinge Pins into bushing and slot of Support Bracket. Any way you can run the cables through the wall from the networking cabinet into the main cabinet to the right, and store all of your networking gear in there?

Mount the router to the wall above wires door from the outside and drill some hole through the door for the cables. But it's kinda dumb that you can't get the front door off rack 6 without removing the doors from 1-5 first.
