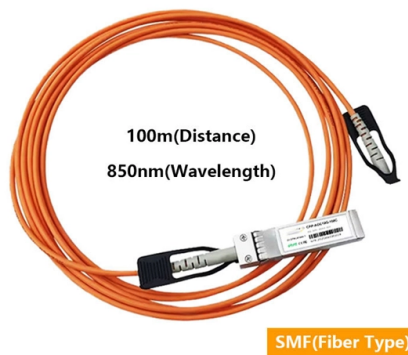


MPO fiber optic connector ferrule guide pin
