"All Cisco Catalyst 9400 Series line cards support hot swapping, which lets you install, remove, replace, and rearrange line cards without powering off the system. Powering off the system hardware

First, manually power off all of the flash storage nodes and disk storage nodes by setting the power switches to the OFF position. Then, manually power off all of the disk storage node expansions.
