

Mechanical traction for laying optical cables in ducts



Overview

Blowing uses continuous airflow or water flow to suspend and push the cable forward through the duct. Pulling relies on mechanical traction applied via rope, winch, or pulling eye. While both techniques achieve the same goal—placing fiber cables inside ducts—their engineering mechanics, tension characteristics, duct preparation requirements, and environmental. When working in manholes, precautions must be taken to limit the amount of exposure to lead. Strictly observe your company's lead handling procedures to eliminate this hazard. Failure to do so may result in serious, long-term health problems. CAUTION: Care must be taken to avoid cable damage during. Fiber optic cable is usually (but not always) installed in an innerduct that provides mechanical protection for the fiber optic cable. The cable installation method is selected based on site conditions and availability of machinery & resources. Table 1 shows a comparison between the two installation methods.

Do not use automated figure-eight machines when installing fiber optic cables with a central tube design or any loose tube cable having one or more layers of corrugated steel armor.
