

Method for testing air leakage in junction boxes



Overview

This method applies air pressure to the test object (workpiece), then measures the change in internal pressure to determine leaks. Air leak testing is a common method used by manufacturers. 1 Air leakage between an air distribution system and unconditioned spaces affects the energy losses from the distribution system, the ventilation rate of the building, and the entry rate of air pollutants. 2 The determination of infiltration energy loads and ventilation rates of residences and.
