

National Standard Thickness Requirements for Distribution Boxes



Overview

The steel plate used for the enclosure of distribution boxes shall have a thickness of not less than 1. All provisions comply with national standards and design requirements to ensure safe and. 1. 0 All boxes shall conform to the latest edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC) NFPA70 and the applicable NEMA Standards. These Distribution Cabinets are to be outdoor type and to be fabricated out of 2 mm GI sheet steel. The body of the boxes shall have sufficient reinforcement with suitable size of channels keeping a provision for fixing and conforming to general. According to national standards, the wall thickness of the low-voltage distribution box should not be less than 1.5mm, and the metal auxiliary pole should be 1. The handle of the isolator should 3 or more in n r mm (minimum) in length on cable connection side as shown in the drawings.
