

National Standard for Parallel Wiring of Distribution Boxes



Overview

Parallel conductor installations are covered in NEC ® 310. 10 (H) and are permitted for each phase, polarity, neutral, or grounded conductor in sizes 1/0 AWG and larger. Joining conductors in parallel is like having two or more smaller conductors connected at each end to make one. In the 2017 NEC, parallel conductors inside an auxiliary gutter must be grouped together to prevent current imbalance in the paralleled conductors due to inductive reactance. Expanding on this, parallel conductors should have the same length, material and insulation type, and be connected identically. Summary: The National Electrical Code explains the Maximum Number of Wires that can be installed into a box, otherwise known as Box Fill. This code is based upon the type of box, wires, wire sizes, wire clamps and conduit fittings. Whether in a home or an industrial facility, this box keeps your electrical setup organized, functional, and efficient.
