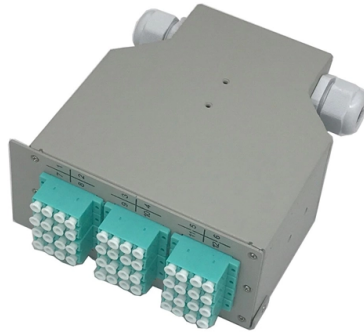


Odf fusion splicing and fixing optical cable

Optical fiber fusion splicing usually takes a little less time than previous steps – cable punch down, splice closure / ODF. An optical Distribution Frame (ODF) or patch panel is the starting point for optical cables, most commonly found in rack cabinets in Head End (HE)/Central Office (CO)/Point of Presence (POP)/Data Centre (DC) or smaller cabinets or enclosures. Multimode fiber is more often spliced by mechanical splices, as the higher loss is acceptable, reflectance is not a problem, and fusion.
