Overview

An out-of-band management switch (also known as an out-of-band serial console or console server) creates an entirely separate, parallel network that's dedicated to the management, orchestration, and troubleshooting of production network infrastructure. A typical Out of Band (OoB) Network refers to a specialized, purpose-built management infrastructure designed explicitly to provide secure, reliable, and continuous access to mission-critical production devices, commonly referred to as Managed Network Devices. Nodegrid empowers organizations to streamline remote infrastructure management, quickly recover. out of band just means “does not pass through the normal network operation path”. To use this port, the switch must have an IP address. IP settings can be. The management network can be deployed in out-of-band or in-band mode, as shown in Figure 2-6.
