Let's start with an example! The network in the picture above is relatively simple. I have one computer connected to a switch. The workflow includes procedures to configure a peer. Let's start with layer 2 to allow each esxi host to use 1 port from each switch: My suggestion is to not use LACP, or any kind of interface bundling in the network. Not only is this much easier, it is also the recommended way from VMWare.
