

Should fire alarm lines be routed through cable trays



Overview

Use separate cable trays or conduit for fire alarm cables to prevent interference from power cables or other electrical circuits. The commissioning agents for the project have recently told us that this is against code, however in speaking with our fire alarm subcontractor they do not believe that to be the case -. Coordinate with Building Structure: Cable tray routing should align with architectural design, avoiding unnecessary crossings, detours, or overlaps with other pipelines. Shortest and Straightest Path: To reduce cable loss and simplify maintenance, cable routes should be as short and straight as. The primary function of fire alarm system cables is to carry signals between detection devices, notification appliances, control panels, and interfaced systems (such as suppression systems, elevators, HVAC, and smoke control). Because these signals are essential for early detection and occupant. UK electrical and fire safety standards do not prescribe a fixed minimum separation distance for roof-mounted life-safety cable trays. However, BS 7671, BS 8519, and BS 5839 collectively establish that life-safety circuits must be installed on dedicated containment and be either separated by. Am I correct in thinking that cabling for a fire alarm should still be routed separately from that for all other services?

A client has had the cabling all installed (for aesthetic reasons I am sure!) in open cable trays with all services together and what looks like plastic cable ties clipping. Cable trays play a key part in keeping fire protection systems working. They can help stop fire from spreading.
