

Should fire-fighting cable trays be fireproof



Overview

Only use fireproof trays for flame containment or isolation, not for unrelated functions. This includes checking their flammability, smoke production, toxic gas emissions, and ability to block heat and fire. Do not modify or damage the trays; however, as an alternative DIN 4102-12 can be used. This is a test for electric cable systems that are required to maintain circuit integrity, so is therefore written around and is dependent on the cables themselves, but contains a minimum of 90 minutes (the maximum time covered by DIN 4102-12). To uncover the answer to this question, we have conducted tests on cable tray systems in different materials.
