Only use fireproof trays for flame containment or isolation, not for unrelated functions. Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed. Segregation of Power and Signal Cables: Power (high-voltage) and signal (low-voltage) cables should be routed separately, using dedicated trays to minimize electromagnetic interference.
