Purpose of the green (ready), orange (>95) and red (>105) indicators on H, J and L breaker trip units Circuit Breaker When the green LED is flashing, the electronic trip. Status LED Blinking Green - Indicates normal operation and load current. Status LED Blinking Red - Indicates an internal problem (trip actuator coil, firmware error, or mechanism error). The breaker/trip unit should be replaced. Status LED Off - Indicates there is no auxiliary power applied AND. At-a-glance red, green, or white indicators appear in the rocker handle of each circuit breaker as well LED lights on the body of the AFCI, GFCI and AFCI/GFCI circuit breakers. The color indicator in the handle indicates whether power on that circuit is ON or OFF; if the status is green, power is.
