Overview

A patch panel is a passive network device used to organize and connect multiple network cables in a structured cabling system. They come in a range of sizes, and are typically mountable, whether that's on a wall, or on a rack to make for easier. A patch panel is one of those components that is easy to overlook when planning a network — it does not switch, route, or process data, and to the uninitiated it can look like an expensive way to add an extra set of connectors between the cable and the switch. It doesn't process data like a switch or router - instead, it acts as a central hub that links incoming and outgoing connections. In the real world—wiring closets, server racks, and busy data centers—your patch panel is where Ethernet performance, labeling discipline, and day-2 operations collide. Choose the wrong type and the network may still pass traffic, but.
