

What is the maximum number of circuits in a landscape electrical distribution box



Overview

There are no limits on the number of junction boxes (without devices) in any particular circuit. Each piece of 'utilization equipment' reduces the maximum allowable load by its nameplate rating, 180va for each receptacle, and each light fixture at its maximum labeled.
