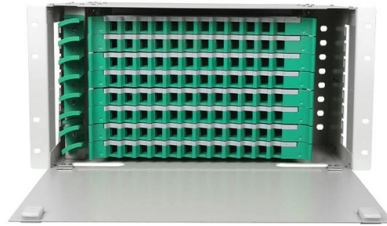


What is the tapping unit of the small busbar



Overview

Power is taken from busbar trunking by the use of tap off units which connect at defined positions along the busbar trunking, and allow power to be taken from the system, usually via a suitable overcurrent protective device. Busbar Trunking Unit : A unit of a BTS such as a straight length, angle (elbow), tee piece etc. Distribution Busbar Trunking: Busbar trunking having tap-off outlets on one or more faces. Angle Unit: Busbar trunking, which. Panelboards and deadfront switchboards are not Listed to have their busbars tapped unless there are existing holes in the busbars marked with the word "Tap" adjacent to the holes. Other holes in the busbar that are not marked with the word "Tap" are intended for the connection of overcurrent. What is a bus bar?
