The cable tray provides a continuous metal support path, which is beneficial for placing the power distribution terminal strip cable in the center of the cable path, thereby reducing the path length of the cross-line and facilitating branch wiring within the cable tray. These Guidance Notes provide ABS recommendations for the design and construction of cable trays and junction boxes. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when. Cable tray systems are alternatives to wire ways and electrical conduit, which completely enclose cables. Cable trays are capable of supporting all types of wiring: such as High Voltage Power Lines.
