A pigtail, when we're talking about electrical wiring, is made up of the three wires — hot, neutral, and ground — that go from a connector, such as a WAGO lever nut or traditional wire nut, to a receptacle when you have multiple pieces of Romex coming into the electrical box. If you have an. Power enters through connectors like WAGO 221 lever nuts, splitting into two directions. One path feeds the immediate receptacle, while the other continues to downstream components.
